W.J. Maloney Plumbing, Heating & Cooling Begins Work On New Chicago Cubs Spring Training Complex

(MESA, Ariz.) W.J. Maloney Plumbing, Heating & Cooling has begun work on the new Chicago Cubs Spring Training Complex in Mesa.

W.J. Maloney is responsible for all the plumbing on the design/assist project, which will include a stadium, clubhouse, practice fields, maintenance building and batting tunnels.

The \$99 million complex, located in the city of Mesa, is expected to open in November, 2013. Hunt Construction Group is the general contractor.

Baseball complexes are not new to W.J. Maloney. In 2009, the company completed work on the Los Angeles Dodgers portion of the Camelback Ranch Spring Training Complex in Glendale, Ariz., which is shared by the Dodgers and the Chicago White Sox. W.J. Maloney's work included gas, water, waste and vent, and rain water piping. A five-acre lake, located between the Dodgers' and White Sox' fields, is used for irrigation of the fields and landscaping of the site. The lake uses reclaimed water and is stocked with fish. Mortenson Construction was the general contractor.

In 2010, W. J. Maloney completed the water, waste and venting, storm water piping and water pipe insulation for the Miracle League of Arizona's facilities. The

league allows children with special needs to play baseball on fields and within facilities that are specially designed, constructed and maintained. The facilities contain rubberized fields, scoreboards and fencing. Hunt Construction Group was the general contractor.

“We have certainly developed an expertise for projects like this,” said Kathryn “Kitty” Maloney-Langmade, president of W.J. Maloney. “On top of being able to provide the varied plumbing services needed for the complex, we are proud to be a part of the Valley’s baseball community, which is so vital to Arizona’s economy.”
