W.J. Maloney Plumbing Selected as the *Reeves Journal* First-Ever Western Contractor of the Year

(PHOENIX – Sept. 18, 2015) W.J. Maloney Plumbing has been selected as the first-ever *Reeves Journal* Western Contractor of the Year and will be featured in the publication's September issue.

Reeves Journal is the oldest publication in the plumbing industry, founded in 1920. The monthly publication serves the Western United States' plumbing, heating and cooling (P-H-C) industry by delivering information that is topical, timely and relevant to its readers.
